









Recycled Bug Decorations

Get ready for the spring and make some ladybirds, bumblebees and butterflies using empty toilet roll tubes.

What you will need:

-  Paper or card
-  Scissors
-  Paints
-  Glue
-  Colouring pencils
-  At least 3 empty toilet roll tubes (1 toilet roll tube = 1 bug)



Instructions:

1. Collect your empty toilet roll tubes and using the paint, paint them the colours you want for your bugs (black for a ladybird, yellow and black stripes for a bumblebee and purple or blue for a butterfly).
2. Whilst these are drying, print out page 1 and 2, card works better than paper.
3. Colour in the wings, eyes and antennas.
4. Then, carefully cut them out.
5. Once the toilet roll tubes have dried, use a gluestick to glue on the eyes, wings and antennas (take a look at the examples on page one so you can see where each can be glued).
6. Pop them on your bedside table and get ready for the spring!
